

### The promise of a satellite account on culture

- based on the system of national accounts
  - which, in turn, is based on the international statistical standard (SNA2008) = comparability
  - represents the most reliable statistical informationreliability
  - is produced annually = time-series
- enables making visible what otherwise remains invisible in the SNA

## Satellite accounts on culture in the EU and elsewhere

- Satellite accounts in use in FI and SP and
- being developed in PT and interest in several EU MSs
- also in operation or planned e.g. in Columbia,
  Chile, Mexico, the USA

#### The way forward

- Political commitment by the EU MSs
- Recommendation by ESSnet culture

  - 2) by individual states together
  - 3) work coordinated by Eurostat
  - 4) work coordinated e.g. by OECD
